## CLASSROOM CORNER

What an exciting year we have had so far in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade! The students are amazed at how far we've come since September! Every day, I feel blessed to work at St. Peter's with my children and family (students, staff and parents). We LOVE the LORD!

Religion is so enjoyable in our room. We love to take turns praying aloud and sharing devotions in our class. We are learning about God the Father's Gracious Gifts. We will be learning about how all things have come to be, how God cares for our world, how God cares for us, and how we use God's gifts.

Reading for enjoyment has always been a passion of mine! I love to share my love for reading with my students. In our next Unit in Reading, we are studying about People and Nature. Our story we will be reading is about a little girl known as the "Gardener" in her Uncle's neighborhood. This little girl loves flowers! She plants a flower garden on the roof of her Uncle's bakery using seeds her Grandmother sent her, and whatever she can find to plant them in. We are also reading multicultural stories from all over the World! These stories are opening our eyes to other cultures and what is going on in the world with kids our age.

Third grade has been working hard to learn their multiplication and division facts! To help assist in learning their facts, the students have been using the "Touch Math" program. The students are able to learn and understand how to multiply and divide with the benefit of Touch Math. This program involves using counting techniques with dots in certain places on every number. Each number is skip-counted a specific way. Currently, the third graders are starting to take timed multiplication and division tests!

In Science, we are studying Forms of Energy: how forms can take energy, how you can describe heat, what is sound, how light allows you to see objects, and electricity. We are very excited to conduct experiments throughout the Unit. One of our grandparents is going to come in to do an electricity lesson with us in Jan! We are really enjoying the new Science and Social Studies curriculums. In Social Studies, we just finished learning about Mexico. We ended the Unit on Mexico with a Mexican Fiesta in class. We have now shifted to Canada. We will be studying the land of Canada, its history, how Canada is governed, living in Canada, and its culture. We will hopefully try Poutine from Canada at the end!

We hope you had a very Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! May your life be filled with loved ones and joy in 2019! Half of the school year may **almost** be gone, but there is still lots to learn and accomplish! Keep working hard everyone!
