It is with great anticipation that I welcome the second quarter of the school year! I look forward to the students learning many new things in Spanish as well as experiencing new things in Art.

Looking back on the first quarter, I am very pleased with the progress that the students showed in Spanish. The fifth graders were so excited about everything new that they learned, which included numbers, color words, common greetings and words related to Thanksgiving. The sixth through eighth graders spent time reviewing much of what they learned last year, telling time, common phrases and greetings, as well as verb meanings and conjugation. We continue to learn the proper pronunciation of words, and I am pleased with the participation of the students as they are expected to read aloud in class.
