CLASSROOM CORNER

3rd Grade Classroom Corner

Going into my 12th year as a teacher at St. Peter's, I count my blessings every day. Every year, I am given a class I love! God has blessed me by bringing me here to grow in my faith with my children. This year, we are "Stopping, Looking, and Listening" to God's Word together.

In Religion, we have been learning about how the Holy Spirit blesses the Church. We are studying how the Holy Spirit brings us to faith, how the Holy Spirit keeps us in faith, what makes up the Church, and we'll be learning about Martin Luther and the 95 Theses. We will be exploring the importance of Reformation Day.

Reading is one of our favorite subjects in 3rd grade. We love getting lost in our stories and books. In our first unit, we are reading stories about Dollars and Sense. Two of our favorite stories were "Boom Town" and "Alexander, Who Used to be Rich Last Sunday." We sure laughed throughout the story about Alexander. Along with Reading, this class loves to write, especially in their journals!

In Math, the 3rd graders are reviewing addition with greater numbers. We will then be moving into subtraction. The students will be reviewing how to subtract top – bottom starting in the ones place. Also, borrowing when we can't subtract is a challenge they are going to excel at. We will also be subtracting across zeros, which will be exciting!

In Science, we are learning about Observing Matter. We have been studying the properties of matter, measuring matter, and solids, liquids, and gases. We are looking forward to all of the projects we will be doing this year in Science.

Social Studies has been fun learning about life in different communities. We will be visiting 5 destinations around the world this year: Mexico, Canada, South Africa, Italy, and China. At the end of each unit, we hope to enjoy food from those destinations. Third graders are excited about different foods! We can't wait to have our Mexican Fiesta!

Third grade is an exciting year! The students are expanding their knowledge. We are growing in our faith as a family by "Stopping, Looking, and Listening!"
