CLASSROOM CORNER

It is a new year with new adventures and opportunities for 4th graders. We wasted no time and dove right in to all the fun. Here is what we've been enjoying!

Math: We just completed NYS Common Core Module 1. The students rocked place values, rounding, and algorithms for addition and subtraction.

English Language Arts: The entire first NYS Common Core Module deals with the Haudenosaunee, people of the longhouse. We've been able to learn about and study the cultures that are right in our backyard and even in our classroom! Keep an eye out for their longhouse projects.

Social Studies: All of the students took their first Social Studies test last week. We now move into the curriculum that crosses over in our E.L.A., expanding the students' knowledge of the first people in New York State.

Science: We are wrapped up our first chapter which was on plants and animals. We've got some beautiful pictures of leaves in our classroom to show we learned the parts of a leaf.

Bible: The students are busily memorizing their parts for our special Reformation Chapel on October 26th. Come check out our Chapel to see what it's all about!
