## **CLASSROOM CORNER**

I Can!

Second grade is taking on an "I can" attitude. Many times we tend to say I can't to new assignments, adventures, problems. Yet, we read in Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." The Lord gives us strength to get up each day and face our work. We can because He did! Check out our I Can wall when you visit. We are proud of all the Lord is helping us with.

In Bible we are learning about Joseph and Moses. The Lord helped both of these men through very tough times. We are memorizing our Bible verses and starting to learn the books of the Old Testament. In math we finished our first chapter and are on to the second one learning how to add using number lines, dominoes, and a hundreds chart. We are using flash cards and are playing "Around the World" to help us remember all of our sums. We are building our reading vocabulary and increasing our speed and fluency in reading. The students have been writing interesting stories in creative writing. Remembering to capitalize our sentences and use punctuation are two of our goals. We are writing a main idea and interesting details in our paragraphs. In social studies we are starting our continent books. We are "traveling" to each continent and exploring what is interesting about each place. In science we are learning land and water forms. The students are working on a project at home about the pond. We will be sharing them at open house. We are enjoying our jungle where we read stories. The class has learned their routine and are becoming fine second graders. They have learned that they CAN do new classwork, problems, and lessons because the Lord gives us strength and He is helping us.
