Dear Parents and Guardians:

One of our main priorities for this school year is the Health and Safety of our students and staff. Although we do not have any active COVID-19 cases within our school, at this time, we are noticing an uptick throughout our area compared to last September.

We would like to remind parents that it is extremely important that you monitor your child's health and keep him/her home if they show ANY signs of COVID-19. Temperatures should be taken daily prior to arriving at school. **Any child with a fever greater than 100.0 F without fever reducing medicine must be kept home.**

As a reminder, COVID-19 symptoms may include:

- **Fever or chills**
- **Cough**
- **Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing**
- **Fatigue**
- **Muscle or Body Aches**
- **Headache**
- **New loss of taste or smell**
- **Sore Throat**
- **Congestion or runny nose**
- **Nausea or vomiting**
- **Diarrhea**

If your child is sent home from school with symptoms of COVID-19, we must follow the "Return to School" guidelines from the Niagara County Department of Health (NCDH). Please see the attached updated form. In summary, he/she will need one of the following to return to school:

- **Negative COVID-19 Test**
- **Alternate Diagnosis from a Healthcare Provider**
- **10 days from symptoms onset & symptoms are improving & fever-free for 24 hours.**

If we have a positive COVID-19 case within our school, we will follow all NCDH guidelines which include contact tracing to see who will need to quarantine. This will be done on a case by case basis.

As a reminder, if your child rides a school bus they are to sit only with someone who resides within their household. If possible, the seat in front and behind them should be empty. Masks are to be worn for the entire ride. Buses have contact tracing guidelines as directed by the NCDH.

We continue to pray for the health and safety of all our school families!
