The fifth graders continue to get excited over new things that they are introduced to and will begin the new quarter learning common conversation phrases. Some of the most recent things that we learned include the days of the week, months of the year, parts of the body and foods. In grade 6, we recently learned how to tell time in Spanish and are currently learning numbers to 100. The 7th graders just completed the chapter on adjectives and have begun creating a book based on the English book, Brown Bear, Brown Bear, by Eric Carle. In 8th grade we are beginning to review each chapter in the Spanish book as we get closer to the end of the year and the Spanish Proficiency Exam. Even though it is uncertain at this time if the exam will be administered this year, we will spend the last quarter of the year reviewing.

In Art, the students at each grade level learned about the Color Wheel and how colors are related to each other. The Kindergarten and first graders enjoyed mixing play dough with primary colors to produce secondary colors. They then colored what they discovered on a color wheel. The other grade levels mixed primary colors with tempera paints and painted a color wheel. It is interesting how different colors can compliment each other and create such a vibrant look!

God created such a colorful world! Even though winter is not considered a very colorful season, spring is! We can begin to see the fresh and vibrant palette of God's colorful creation. Nature regenerates and everywhere fresh green pops up along with an array of colors as flowers begin to bloom.

NYS ELA EXAMS

New York State has applied for a waiver through the Federal Government that would allow NYS Testing to be canceled for this year. As of this date that waiver has been denied. However, they have made some changes to both the ELA and Math Exams that are upcoming. There will only be one day of testing for each of these subjects and the style of test will be Multiple Choice Questions. Our plan is to give the ELA exam on Tuesday, April 20th to students in grades 3-8. We will keep you updated if any additional changes are made.
