I consider it a blessing to teach Bible Studies to all students in grades 4-8. I am thankful for the opportunity to work with all students in these grade levels. Teaching Religion gives me the opportunity to incorporate some creative and fun activities, which all students seem to enjoy!

7th and 8th Graders are studying the life of Moses and the gift of the Ten Commandments. We are learning that as forgiven children we should always shine our light for Him. We focus on these core values that are so important. We are also watching the movie Facing the Giants and discussing the life lessons the main characters are learning. We are seeing the importance of relying on God to help us face the challenges that come our way.

6th Graders will soon be learning about the first 12 disciples. We will research each Apostle and learn that much of the information we find isn't always accurate. We will base our facts on scripture that we read in God's word, the Bible.

4th and 5th Graders are learning about the power of the Holy Spirit. We are discussing ways in which He works on our hearts as we make daily decisions. We want to make sure that all our choices are pleasing to Him.

In my 5th-8th Character Ed classes we enjoy putting puzzles together. We change groups often. It is fun for me to watch each group tackle the puzzle they have been given. It's a great lesson in how to work together. We also spend time completing some logic puzzles. These can be challenging, but the students do a great job in solving them. Each class will be doing some fun crafts in the months of February and March.

I had a lot of fun visiting the following classrooms before Christmas: PreK 3, PreK 4, Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th. I read a story to many of them, and each got to do a craft. I look forward to doing another activity with each class this spring.
