CLASSROOM CORNER

Third graders have been doing a fantastic job in Reading and Math! We love reading! We are just finishing a unit in Reading about "One of a Kind." We have been reading about differences in people, the hottest, coldest, highest, and deepest places in the world, life during the Depression, and Gertrude Ederle...America's Champion Swimmer. All of our stories led the way to deep discussions in our class. In Math, we are working on multiplication, division, and will be starting fractions. We will also be doing more in-depth work on bar graphs, pictographs, and line graphs. Currently, the students are taking timed tests for multiplication and division. Soon, they will be filling up their math facts pictures in class. They have to earn a 100% on a timed quiz (1 minute) to fill in each flower for the different facts.

Science has been really exciting! We are just finishing a chapter on Forces and Motion. We have learned about doing work, levers and pulleys, more simple machines, and compound machines. Now, we are learning about Plant and Animal Adaptations. Also, in preparation for our chapter on animals, we will have butterfly caterpillars in the room. We will have the opportunity to observe them go through metamorphosis to become butterflies. It will be an amazing sight!

In Social Studies, 3rd graders have been studying Communities. We just finished learning about a Native American Community and Jamestown. We are heading into learning about building new communities, moving to a new home, and how cities grow and change.

In Religion, 3rd graders are just starting a Unit on How God Hears and Answers His People. We will be discussing if God hears and answers our prayers, how we talk to God, how we live for Christ, why we pray "Thy Kingdom Come", for what should we pray, how God helps us resist temptation, how God delivers us from evil, and why we can pray with confidence. These students love our discussions in class that share our thoughts, prayers, and questions. "My Life is in Your Hands, Lord" has been a phenomenal theme for our school this year! We love to share our love for Christ with our school friends and family! I love the giving hearts in my classroom. Every year here at St. Peter's, I feel blessed to have my children, families, and friends at school.
