With winter almost behind us, I am so ready to welcome spring. Spring is a time of new beginnings as the snow has melted and warm, sunny days are right around the corner. Nature is coming back to life and the season of Lent is upon us. Here's what's happening in middle school:

The 8th grade math students have completed their first extensive unit in algebra. We are now moving on to geometry which includes transformations, congruence, and similarity. Other topics we cover include angle relationships, volume, and the Pythagorean Theorem.

In 7th and 8th grade science, we recently completed a unit on our solar system. It included studying the planets, sun, and moon. This helped us to prepare for and understand the upcoming solar eclipse. For Social Studies, we have finished our unit on the Revolutionary War and our focus is now on the creation of a new nation and its government.

For 6th grade Social Studies, we continue to learn about ancient cultures. In our study of Ancient Greece, we have explored Athens and Sparta, and how these ancient cultures affected our world today. We learned about Greek gods and goddesses, ancient philosophers, and Aesop's fables. Looking ahead, we will be learning about Ancient India, Ancient China, and Ancient Rome. In science, we have concluded our unit on weather, the Earth, and its atmosphere. The next unit of study is in Life Science. Topics include classification of living things, plants, animals, and their interdependence. The middle school students continue to work hard!
