Middle School at a glance...

**Math:** With New York State testing behind us, the 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade math classes are looking ahead to topics that will help prepare them for next year. In 6<sup>th</sup> grade, we will be concentrating on understanding data and statistics. The 8<sup>th</sup> graders will be learning how to apply the Pythagorean Theorem, and how to solve algebraic equations using square and cube roots.

**Science:** The 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> graders are working on their final chapters in our Life Science Unit. They explored the structures and process of plants and animals, and the impact of environmental conditions and how living things interact with each other. The 8<sup>th</sup> graders are preparing for the upcoming New York State Science test. The hand-on performance test is scheduled for May 25-27, and the written portion is scheduled for June 6.

**Social Studies:** In 6<sup>th</sup> Social Studies, we continue learning about ancient cultures. Our latest chapters are on the rise and fall of the Roman Empire. We will also touch upon early African civilizations and medieval Europe.

Our theme for this school year has been kindness. As we wind down our school year, let us let kindness carry us through. Lord, help each of us to show kindness to others and have a loving heart.


