Time Marches On

As we are nearing the end of our first marking period I can only thank the Lord for all that He has done with and through these students. I remember our first few weeks, the students would just look at me when I would ask them to do something. I don't think they actually thought they could do it, but now they are flying and I am looking at them amazed at how much they are able to accomplish.

In math we have been working on our addition facts. The students love playing "Around the World" and passing those timed drill sheets. We add an "ice cream scoop" to our cones with each passed drill sheet. Some have some very large cones, Dee Dee size! We have been reading and adding to our vocabulary. The students are working on different writing projects and learning how to make creative sentences that are more descriptive. In science we have been learning about rocks, minerals, and soil. We went to our science lab downstairs and studied different minerals. Social studies is full of making and reading maps. The second graders have also enjoyed art. They have learned about primary colors, the Dutch painter Piet Mondrian that painted different shapes and pointillism with the painter Georges Seurat. Our Bible time has been about following the Israelites from Egypt and seeing how the Lord took care of them. We are working on learning the books of the Bible and various memory verses.

Second graders are very busy. Each moment is used to help us learn all that we need to know to become a wonderful third grader. Yes, that day will come before we know it because time marches on.
