We are a class of 10 boys and one courageous and patient, sweet girl. □ This mix makes for interesting lessons. They are very competitive, and we use that to good use. Many games help us learn our memory verses, math facts, reading skills, and best of all good behavior. Second grade is growing in leaps and bounds. The best lesson they are learning is that all we do is for the Lord, and we want to give Him our best.

In math we are mastering addition and subtraction. Our science class is looking at natural resources, living and non-living items. Social studies is all about landforms, continents, maps and the globe. We made clay landforms and have worked with many maps. We started cursive writing! The students love cursive and are really coming along. We are adding to our reading vocabulary, working in phonics, and have read many stories. They are also writing many different types of stories too. Learning to make good sentences and then paragraphs is a daily goal. Most importantly our class is learning about the Lord. We just finished the second workbook that shared about the Israelites going into the promise land. They were by no means perfect, yet the Lord still worked with them and through them. On Thursday, November 9th we will be hosting our annual Veteran's Day Chapel. We are inviting all Veterans to join us for this special day. If you have a family member or friend who is serving or served in any branch of the military, please invite them. The service will begin at 8:40am in the church.

As part of our service every year we give to a military service. This year, since our focus in giving is children, we will be giving our offering to Operation Purple Camp. Operation Purple Camp offers military kids a **free** week of camp where they connect with other kids, just like them. Most military kids live in civilian communities where their peers, neighbors, teachers, health providers, and coaches have little understanding of their experience.

At Operation Purple Camp, they meet kids like them who understand what it's like for a parent to serve in the military...and make life-long friends! Campers thrive in an environment with fully trained counselors and camp staff experienced in helping children adapt and overcome the stressors of military life. This is often one of the only touchpoints for kids who do need some extra support to connect with ongoing resources for their mental health.

Campers are encouraged to celebrate the sacrifices they make in ways that make them proud of their role as a military kid!
