## **CLASSROOM CORNER**

We are off to a great start in Spanish this year. The 5<sup>th</sup> graders are excited about learning a new language! We began by learning color words, numbers and some common greetings. In 6<sup>th</sup> grade the students have been expanding their Spanish vocabulary by learning Spanish expressions, family vocabulary and words that are similar in both Spanish and English. The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders have been concentrating on the vowel sounds and pronunciation of words as well as increasing their vocabulary. We have concentrated on translating Spanish into English to help us prepare for the Spanish Proficiency exam in June. There are a number of new students in Spanish this year, and I am pleased at how well they are catching on!

In Art, the students in kindergarten through grade 8 started out the year by doing a project related to this year's school theme, "Choose Joy". The students used a variety of media including water color, colored pencils, crayons, tissue paper and tempera paint and used different Art techniques as well. We then moved on to doing something special with our names as we continue to get to know each other better. We have also enjoyed doing projects centered around the fall season including squirrels, scarecrows, watercolors, and fall collages. While the students are experimenting with watercolor, I have been teaching them the importance of shading, and they are doing a great job!

Autumn is such a beautiful time of year and without a doubt, God is the master artist. The leaves change from green to an incredible display of vibrant colors. This year the colors seem to be especially brilliant in color!
