2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 3:16- All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness.

This year I have the privilege of teaching Bible Studies and Social Studies to students in grades 7 and 8.

I know many people find the preteen and teenage years of child rearing to be very challenging. Educators, too, recognize that this age group can be difficult to teach. I am often searching for creative ways to reach children who don't appear interested in the subjects I teach.

Even though the majority of our students are being raised in a Christian environment, they are not perfect. As they age, they often exhibit behaviors that have not been evident in them before. For example, they may refuse to participate in discussions, when before they were willing and eager. Teenagers may use language and tone of voice that are not appropriate; especially in a learning environment. As they seek acceptance and the desire to be "popular" they may act in ways that appear "cool" in their eyes.

As I teach, I do my best to include each student in the discussion. I've learned not to be discouraged by the difficult behaviors I encounter. Instead, I remind myself that the children I have grown to love are still alive and growing. As they physically grow and change, they are spiritually growing as well. They need to be reminded that their words and actions contribute to their character. It's important to develop this character in a way gives honor and glory to God.

My prayer for each of you, as parents, is that as you encounter a change in attitude with your child, please be loving and patient, as well as firm in your correction and discipline. Children need boundaries and they need to know that there are consequences to the actions they choose. Please remember to pray for the students we lovingly educate.

I am looking forward to a wonderful year where my students and I can explore and learn God's word together. We will also have the opportunity to recognize the importance of historical events and how they impact our lives today. Thank you for choosing to send your child to St. Peter's this school year!
