## SAFETY REMINDER

In an effort to make sure everyone is safe, we ask parents/grandparents to be aware of the following:

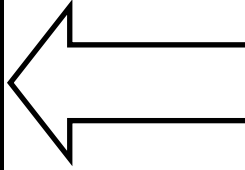
